Year End Giving

Thank you to all for your generous support of the ministries of Salem.

As we approach year-end, please note that for tax reporting purposes, donations must be made by December 31 in order to be included on your 2022 giving record. If you are mailing a check to the church, it must be postmarked by December 31.

In the course of year-end tax planning, you may find yourself considering special one-time donations. As you contemplate year-end gifts, please keep Salem in mind. We welcome your donations through check, online at https://salemchurch.life/give, through the mobile app Vanco Mobile, or via text to (855) 917-1810.

For those donating with an online recurring contribution, please note that your contribution will end if you requested an end date of December 31, 2022 for this year's transactions. To continue your contributions, you will need to set up a new recurring gift. Simply log into your personal account at https://salemchurch.life/give and set up your recurring giving for 2023.

If you did not request an end date to your recurring contribution AND you wish to change your amount for 2023, you will need to cancel your 2022 contribution after the last payment is made for 2022; then you must add a new transaction for 2023 with your new amount.

If you have not set up a recurring gift, please consider doing so. Our electronic giving program offers convenience for you and provides much-needed donation consistency for our congregation. If you are currently giving on a weekly basis, you will no longer need to write out 52 checks a year or prepare 52 envelopes. When travel, illness or other circumstances prevent you from attending services, this program will allow your weekly offerings to continue on an uninterrupted basis. All electronic donations are directly imported into your giving record, with no need for manual posting. This saves time and improves accuracy of contribution reports. Mission Focus: Change a Child's Story

Our congregation is helping "Change a Child's Story." We are accepting book and monetary donations to buy books for students in need. You're never too young for books. Reading to babies as young as six months of age leads to stronger vocabularies and better early literacy skills four years later, just as the children are getting ready to go to school. Only 53% of children ages three to five are read to daily by a family member. Children in families with incomes below the poverty line are less likely to be read to aloud everyday than are children in families with incomes at or above poverty. It all starts by giving a book as a gift to a child. A child can learn from a book read to them or by them reading a book to their family. Our mission is to make disciples of Jesus who transform the world. We can transform the world when we help a child read a book. Read a book to a child, grandchild or friend on FaceTime or Zoom or video. It makes a huge difference in their lives.

Prayer Tree


Bring a Christmas Ornament for our Prayer Tree before Christmas.

The word Chrismon is a contraction of the two words—Christ and Monogram. A Christmas tree decorated with symbols from Christian history tells a story of the true spiritual meaning of Christmas. Christian monograms or Chrismons have been used throughout the ages as signs of the Christian faith. Chrismons are gold and white, representing majesty and purity. Ideas for fashioning them are developed from early Christian symbols, the Bible and
